### Share the Road Campaign

Share The Road is a road safety campaign led by Leicestershire Police.

The Share the Road campaign focuses on anyone that uses the roads and encourages everyone to treat each other respectfully.

The aim is to ensure that anyone in Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland that uses the road, for any purpose is kept safe.

We have consulted professionals from a number of partners who are supporting our campaign to make the roads a safer place, including: The British Horse Society, British Triathlon and Cycling UK.

#### Advice - Cyclists

Make sure your **intention is clear** and signal to other road users when you intend to turn, giving plenty of notice before manoeuvring.

**Light up!** Legally you are required to have working lights on the front and rear of your cycle, switched on between sunset and sunrise; white at the front, red at the rear.

#### Advice - Car Drivers

Pass cyclists, horse riders and runners wide and slow. The recommended distance is 1.5 metres.

When passing a horse and rider, slow down to a maximum of 15mph and be patient if looking to go around them.

Note the new rural areas where the speed limits have dropped to 50mph

### #YouSaidWeDid

Please find below updates from your local beat team in relation to the priorities you have raised via Neighbourhood Link:

- **You said – Anti-social behaviour (ASB)**  
Issues have been raised in relation to ASB around Brindley Close and Baum Crescent, Stoney Stanton. Officers are continuing proactive patrols in the area identified. There have been no reports this month of increased activity but officers continue to monitor the situation.
- **You Said – Drug Use / Dealing**  
There have been no reports of drug activity of any kind in the Fosse Villages over the past month. Where reports are made officers will make proportionate enquires in relation to them.
- **You Said – Vehicle Crime**  
Local Officers are continuing to monitor vehicle crime across the Fosse Villages Beat Area and are conducting patrols in areas where reports have been made.
- **You Said – Road Safety**  
This month your beat team have conducted a speeding operation around the following villages Elmesthorpe, Aston Flamville, and Thurlaston. Several vehicles were stopped and given advice in relation their speed around the villages.
